# TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM OF THE STATE OF KENTUCKY SPECIAL MEETING OF THE INSURANCE COMMITTEE JUNE 17, 2019

#### Minutes of Meeting:

After giving proper notice of a special meeting, and a quorum being present, Chair Charles Harman called the Insurance Committee to order at 10:30 a.m. on Monday, June 17, 2019, in the boardroom of the Teachers' Retirement System office, 479 Versailles Road, Frankfort, Kentucky.

Ms. Gilbert presented information on two federal issues affecting the 2020 MEHP premium rate. Included in her presentation was information on two plan design changes for the 2020 Medicare Advantage plan.

<u>Committee Action</u>: Upon motion duly made by Ms. McGown and seconded by Mr. Underwood, the committee voted unanimously to increase the member copay to \$120 for a visit to an emergency room; decrease the member copay to \$25 for a visit to an urgent care center; and increase the member copay to \$80 per day for days 21-100 in a skilled nursing facility.

Ms. Gilbert presented information on the pharmacogenomics personalized medicine program.

<u>Committee Action</u>: Upon motion duly made by Mr. Underwood and seconded by Ms. McGown, the committee voted unanimously to add one pharmacist at the rate of \$0.28 and increase two pharmacists to \$0.28 at the Know Your Rx Coalition.

Ms. Gilbert provided information on the MEHP request for proposals. Ms. Gilbert's report was informational, and the committee took no action.

<u>Adjournment</u>: There being no further business to come before the committee and by unanimous consent of the committee, Chair Harman declared the meeting adjourned at 11:31 a.m.
