2. Reports by TRS Staff

2.1. <u>CIO Observations and Comments</u>: Mr. Siderewicz reported to the committee the information on the Quarterly Investment Update for the quarter ended September 30, 2022. The report was informational, and the committee took no action.

2.2. <u>Quarterly Report on Securities Litigation</u>: Mr. Wampler presented the Securities Litigation Report detailing securities litigation activities during the quarter ended September 30, 2022. The report was informational, and the committee took no action.

2.3 <u>Report on Alternative Investments</u>: Ms. Ashby reported to the committee on the private equity portfolio for the quarter ended September 30, 2022. The report was informational, and the committee took no action.

2.4. <u>Private Equity Discussion – Energy</u>: Ms. Ashby reported to the committee on NGP Natural Resources XIII .

<u>Committee Action</u>: Upon motion duly made by Mr. Alverson and seconded by Mr. Collecchia, the committee unanimously approved staff's recommendation for an investment in NGP Natural Resources XIII of \$40 million from the Retirement Annuity Trust and \$5 million from the Health Insurance Trust .

2.5. <u>Private Equity Discussion – Buyout</u>: Ms. Ashby reported to the committee on Carlyle Partners VIII.

<u>Committee Action</u>: Upon motion duly made by Mr. Collecchia and seconded by Mr. Underwood, the committee unanimously approved staff's recommendation for an investment in Carlyle Partners VIII of \$50 million from the Retirement Annuity Trust, \$10 million from the Health Insurance Trust and \$500,000 from the Life Insurance Trust.

2.6. <u>Securities Lending Review</u>: Mr. Siderewicz gave an update on the TRS securities lending program that the Investment Committee approved in 2016. The report was informational, and the committee took no action.

2.7. <u>Report on Internally Managed Portfolios</u>: Mr. Siderewicz reported to the committee on the internally managed portfolios for the quarter ended September 30, 2022. The report was informational, and the committee took no action.

3. Quarterly Reports by Managers

3.1. Wellington Asset Management reported on the TRS funds managed by the firm. The report was informational, and the committee took no action.
