<u>Committee Action</u>: Upon motion duly made by Mr. Boardman and seconded by Mr. Underwood, the committee unanimously approved staff's recommendation for an investment in Carlyle European Partners VI of \$50 million from the Retirement Annuity Trust, \$10 million from the Health Insurance Trust and \$500,000 from the Life Insurance Trust.
