1. <u>Approval of KEHP Supplement for 2025</u>: Ms. Mangione presented information concerning the recommended Kentucky Employees' Health Plan (KEHP) supplement for 2025.

<u>Committee Action</u>: Upon motion duly made by Mr. Underwood and seconded by Ms. McGown, the committee voted unanimously to recommend to the board a health insurance benefit supplement for KEHP up to \$885.30 per month in 2025 for those retirees fulfilling the necessary service requirements. This includes a KEHP administrative fee of \$8 per person per month (PPPM).

2. <u>Approval of MEHP Rate for 2025</u>: Ms. Dotson presented information concerning the Medicare Eligible Health Plan (MEHP) recommended rate for 2025.

<u>Committee Action</u>: Upon motion duly made by Mr. Underwood and seconded by Mr. Straub, the committee voted unanimously to recommend to the board a rate of \$210 per month in 2025 for the MEHP, which includes a combined UnitedHealthcare Medicare Advantage plan and Express Scripts Medicare Part D drug plan, for those retirees fulfilling the necessary service requirements.

Adjournment: There being no further business to come before the committee, upon a motion made by Mr. Underwood and seconded by Mr. Straub and by unanimous consent of the

committee, Chair Schneider declared the meeting adjourned at 11:17 a.m.
