<u>Board Action</u>: Upon motion duly made by Ms. Sweazy, and seconded by Mr. Sanders, the Board voted unanimously to self-fund the Medicare Part D prescription drug portion of the MEHP and approve the rate up to \$240 per month for the 2015 MEHP PPPM for those retirees fulfilling the necessary service requirements.

6. Economic Outlook

Bos Todd and Curt Scott presented information regarding the current status of the economy and the projected economic outlook. The reports by Messrs. Todd and Scott were informational and the Board took no action.
